Teams for Families

Microsoft Teams is the communication tool FSDB is using to interact with you and your child during distance learning.

Why is it Important Now?

Teams allows for face-to-face video conferencing either on an individual level or as part of a group.

Teams video chat provides individualized interactions between your family and your child's team of teachers, specialists and other staff.

Class meetings are an important component to learning while giving your child opportunities to interact with his/her classmates. Much work will be done on the individualized level. Please prioritize team meeting times.

Specific Strategies for our D/HH and B/VI Kids

- For accessibility purposes, students may find it easier to use a phone or the Teams app.
- Using the blur background feature will cut out unnecessary and visually cluttered backgrounds making it easier to focus on a person's face.
