SKI-HI, INSITE, and VIISA are complete curricula developed by the SKI-HI Institute at Utah State University. These trainings provide research-based information and unbiased resources for professionals who provide family-centered programming to families with young children ages 0-5 who are deaf/hard of hearing, blind/visually impaired, and deafblind.

SKI-HI InstituteTraining is available for educators, early interventionists, and professionals with a Bachelor's Degree and a background in a related field, such as Deaf Education, Child Psychology, Special Education, Speech and Language, Audiology, Vision, Child Development, Early Childhood Education, etc.

Participants must attend ALL days of training for each curriculum course and complete the related homework assignments in order to receive a certificate of completion, valid for five years. Recertification is two days and offered at a reduced rate. Registrations must be received by no later than 10 days prior to the first day of training. The fee for each full SKI-HI Institute training is \$300, payable by check or purchase order to FSDB. Participants are also required to have the INSITE, SKI-HI, or VIISA manuals for each training, which can be ordered through HOPE Publications at hopepubl.com/product-category/basic-curricula.
